

## GOVERNMENT : CASE STUDY 2

### Datacom Installation

SEC Datacom was chosen to assist a central government department upgrade the facilities used by the Witness Protection Programme operated by English and Welsh Crown and Magistrates Courts.

The project involved the installation of audio visual equipment to enable remote witness evidence to be given via a video/audio link from other locations, or rooms within the same court building. In addition the facilities also had to provide document imaging and recording of evidence.

Systems installed to achieve this involved:

- Multimode Fibre
- Cat 5e Structured Cabling
- Audio Visual Equipment
- RGB Cabling

The £500K contract was implemented in two phases over a one year period and involved working with two main contractors. Close liaison with the Client and the main contractors was essential for the design and implementation of the changes to enable the smooth transition to new systems. This involved careful site planning of all processes by SEC Datacom staff to ensure a rapid installation of the services with the minimum of disruption.
