

GOVERNMENT : CASE STUDY 3**Electrical Installation**

To encourage the use of electric boats, a Waterways Authority in the East of England decided to expand their existing network of riverside charging points. After receiving Government Funding a tender was issued and Eastern Contracting was subsequently awarded a contract which included the following:

- Distribution boards in weatherproof enclosures at 8 riverside locations.
- Underground sub main cables to riverside socket posts.
- Cable trenching work.
- Construction of concrete bases for distribution enclosures and the sockets posts.

As this was a CDM Regulated project, Eastern Contracting acted as the Principle Contractor and Planning Supervisor, managing the trenching sub contractor, energy supplier and the meter installer.

On all but one of the sites new electricity supplies were required and Eastern Contracting obtained quotes from the local energy supplier on behalf of the Authority. On two of the sites Eastern Contracting also managed the wayleave negotiations with landowners, and where permission was not forthcoming were able to arrange an alternative means of obtaining a new supply.
